

Camp Rules and Packing List

We have five simple rules that we all live by at Camp Cedar Crest to make sure that camps are fun, safe and a great experience for everyone!

1. Be where you're supposed to be when you're supposed to be there.

All meals, meetings and activities are mandatory. Campers must stay within the camp boundaries at all times.

2. Respect other people and their belongings.

Fighting, hazing, harassing or using foul language is NEVER permitted. Campers are automatically sent home for stealing or "raiding" (raiding is disrupting or damaging someone's cabin or belongings).

3. No illegal stuff.

All articles listed in the leave at home section must NOT be brought to camp!

4. No guys in or around girls' cabins and no girls in or around guys' cabins.

5. You break it you bought it.

All damages to camp property must be paid for prior to leaving camp. Camp Cedar Crest imposes a \$500 fine for graffiti.

These rules are important and we take them seriously! Anyone who breaks them may be sent home early from camp. Parents and/or churches are responsible for the transportation of students who are sent home.

Be Sure to Bring to Camp

- Bible & notebook & pens
- Sleeping bag (put in a plastic bag and label with your name, your church name) & pillow
- Warm clothes for 3 days & 2 nights.
- Toiletries (toothbrush, shampoo, deodorant, etc.)
- Towels and washcloths
- Chapstick / lip balm
- Flashlight
- Spending money (for snack shop)
- Sun screen
- Refillable Water Bottle
 - VERY IMPORTANT!!! Dehydration is the #1 sickness at camp!

Be Sure to Leave at Home

- Electronics (laser pointers, CD players, iPods, MP3 players, laptops, portable DVD players, PSPs, Wii's, etc.)
- Cigarettes, lighters & matches
- Alcohol & drugs
- Weapons of any kind
- Fireworks
- Gum
- Cell phones should be used in emergencies only.
